Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>						
Definitions							
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</p> <p><i>Midwest Independent Bank does not share with our affiliates.</i></p>						
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</p> <p><i>Midwest Independent Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i></p>						
Joint Marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <p><i>Midwest Independent Bank does not jointly market.</i></p>
